A nurse training school was created in Ayos, in 1985 by the French Colonial masters. This school contributed immensely to the training of indigenous physicians in 1939. French Cameroun had a mechanical center and 50 doctors.

Nursing education has moved from apprenticeship models to advanced competency based curricular in higher education.

Bachelor's degree is already becoming the entry level in to professional practice.

- Postgraduate programs has been developed and there is growing autonomous regulation.

Nursing in Cameroon has equally been going through its own evolution from colonial era to present day Cameroon.
