Graduate Diploma in Nursing has remained inaccessible to the majority of Cameroonians up till 2001 that the Cameroon's First Anglo-Saxon State University, the University of Buea sent out its first batch of graduates in Bachelor's degree in Nursing Sciences (BNS), after a four year training program. The duration of training was the same with candidates with nursing background and those without Nursing background

In 2009, the first batch of Masters degree in Nursing education were sent out and the university did not offer any doctoral degrees.

In the late 2000s, the university of Yaounde 1 which is the oldest in Cameroon started a Masters degree program in Nursing Sciences. Since then, entry into practice has been based on three year diploma which can only be obtained from the ministries of Public Health and Higher education.

Preregistration diploma program also continued even as undergraduate programs are now available but however, the pathway to upgrade preregistration and registration diplomas to bachelor degree is still dark and gloomy.
